MEMORIAL MARKERS

According to Jewish tradition, permanent memorial markers can be placed any time after the Shloshim period.

Most of our families purchased their memorial marker as part of their memorial estate plan. Speak to one of our Family Advisors to complete the final wording.

You may be contacted by independent memorial dealers who will offer to sell you a memorial. These dealers are not associated with Hillside Memorial Park. Hillside Memorial Park does not release personal information to these or any other vendors.

Granite memorials are used in many of our ground burial sections. Production and setting of a granite memorial requires eight weeks from the time an order is placed.

Bronze memorials are used on all mausoleum, garden mausoleum and some ground burial sections. Production and setting of bronze memorials requires sixteen weeks from the time an order is placed.

Many families place small stones on the graves of their loved one to mark that the grave has been visited. Hillside Memorial Park is not responsible for damage to any memorial marker that has resulted from the placement of the stones.



FLOWER GUIDELINES

Hillside Memorial Park has established guidelines regarding flowers to maintain the beauty and dignity of the park. We appreciate your cooperation in following these guidelines.

GROUND SPACES

Please do not place artificial flowers or potted plants on ground spaces. We have found it necessary to impose this restriction to keep our park safe and beautiful for the following reasons:

- Artificial flowers or potted plants, which remain indefinitely, must be removed and then replaced every time the grass is cut.
- The wires used in artificial flowers are a serious hazard to the Hillside Memorial Park staff who care for the property and who operate mowing and trimming machinery.
- Water, fertilizer as well as other activities necessary to keep Hillside Memorial Park looking its best cause artificial flowers to deteriorate rapidly.



FLOWERS - WALL CRYPTS & NICHES

Fresh or artificial flowers may be placed on wall crypts or niches. Hillside Memorial Park reserves the right to remove any flowers when their appearance warrants removal.

Anyone who places artificial flowers on wall crypts or niches accepts responsibility for maintaining their appearance. Please be sure flowers do not obscure adjacent memorials.

Hillside Memorial Park is not responsible for the disappearance or loss of flowers.

FLOWER REMOVAL

All wilted flowers are removed every Thursday.
